**PURPOSE:** The Donor Health and Safety Committee is established to address donor health and safety issues, policy considerations and to provide scientific expertise. The committee will encompass both US domestic and global concerns and policy setting across the scope of transfusion medicine and cellular therapies.

- CHARGES:**
1. Identify and address emerging donor health and safety concerns.
  2. Identify overly burdensome FDA regulations which do not contribute to donor health and safety and propose alternatives supported by data.
  3. Explore methods to increase donation safety for all donors with an emphasis on young donors. Develop recommendations for educational materials to inform teens and their parents about the risks of adverse reactions and mitigation strategies.
  4. Pursue initiatives to improve the donation experience.
  5. Champion / support Donor Hemovigilance activities on behalf of AABB.
